ACE Academy teachers will be present Monday through Wednesday to share best practices from their past year at ACE.

Participants will leave with applied curriculum for their classroom and to share with their peers.

- ◆ Complete and submit a daily program log and evaluation
- ◆ Commit to actively participate in roundtable discussions and other activities
- ◆ Commit to attend the fall 2009 Salem Chamber Forum Series Luncheon
